Seller's responsibility:

1. The seller guarantees that the puppy is in good health and has received the following:
 - A. Age-appropriate immunizations.
 - B. Microchip
 - C. Deworming
 - D. Health certificate (available when the Buyer takes possession)

2. Seller provides a two-year health guarantee against life-threatening genetic health problems, 2 years after the date of sale.
 - A. Seller guarantees all possible steps have been taken with the sire/dam selection and breeding to prevent hereditary issues.
 - B. If a congenital defect is identified within the warranty period, The buyer has the option to obtain a replacement puppy from the seller of equal value from the next available litter.
 - i. Original puppy need not be returned, provided there is proper documentation of the congenital issue.
 - ii. The breeder determines which puppy of equal value will be used as a replacement and the weights may be as long as 12-24 months.
 - iii. Color and gender are not guaranteed.
 - iv. Shipping fees will not be refunded, and any costs associated with the shipping replacement Puppy are to be covered by the buyer.
 - C. The puppy is euthanized or in any way disposed of, without a second opinion from the seller's veterinarian, the buyer waives all rights to a replacement Puppy.

D. This warranty does not include viral illness, infections, improper bites, stress-related illness, hernias, hypoglycemia, parasites (including) Cancer, or endocrine disorders. It also does not include any illness due to the ingestion of foreign objects, food, chemicals, or physical injury.

E.No warranties or guarantees expressed or implied, are made under this contract except as stated.

3. It is to be clearly understood, that the seller does NOT, under any circumstances, accept responsibility for any veterinarian and/or health care expense. It is to be clearly understood, that the seller does not, under any circumstances, accept responsibility for any veterinarian and/or health care expense.

Buyer's Responsibility:

1. The buyer agrees to pay the seller a total sum of _____ This fee does not include shipping.
2. The buyer bears all costs relating to the sale of the above animal. The risk of loss or injury to the above animal is on the buyer at all times after the Puppy leaves the Seller.
3. The buyer agrees to have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian within three business days of taking possession.
 - A. If the puppy is found to be in poor health, the buyer has the option of returning the puppy, at the buyer's cost, for a full refund.
 - B. The buyer will provide a written statement from a veterinarian clearly stating the defect or illness.
 - C. If the puppy is not taken to a licensed veterinarian within three business days of taking possession, the health warranty is void.
4. The buyer is responsible for all medical expenses associated with the treatment of intestinal parasites if the puppy is diagnosed.
5. The buyer agrees to provide the best possible care for their puppy for the duration of his or her life. This includes but is not limited to:
 - A. Housing the puppy indoors.
 - B. Eating only premium quality, complete food intended for dogs.
 - C. Maintaining the puppy at a healthy weight.
 - D. Having the puppy seen by a licensed veterinarian for a wellness exam annually.
 - E. Taking their puppy to the licensed veterinarian if he or she gets sick or injured.
 - F. Keeping all immunizations up to date.

6. The seller highly recommends the buyer provide basic obedience training with their puppy within the first year of owning their dog.
7. The buyer agrees to postpone strenuous exercise until after the puppy is over one year of age to minimize joint damage as the Puppy develops.
8. The buyer agrees to contact the seller immediately if the buyer determines they are unable to keep the puppy for any reason. The Buyer and Seller will jointly determine how the dog will be rehomed.
9. If by any case the buyer wants to return the puppy, the seller will take the puppy back but the seller will NOT refund the price.
10. The buyer agrees to never place their puppy with a rescue group, in a shelter, pound, or similar facility.
11. The buyer allows the seller to use any pictures of the dog that the buyer posts on social media for the purposes of reposting and sharing on Instagram or Facebook, their website, or in any manner they choose.

Spay and Neuter Contract:

1. Spaying/neutering by a licensed, reputable veterinarian is required on the above Puppy at 12 months of age.
 - A. Proof of this, in the form of a certificate of spay/neuter from the veterinarian, must be forwarded to the seller by the time the puppy reaches 12 months of age.
 - B. If the seller does not receive this documentation within this time, the warranty will become Null and void.
2. It is understood that at the time of sale that the puppy is not to be used for breeding. It is a representation of its breed and it is structurally and temperamental suited for a companion and/or working dog. **It is being sold as a pet without breeding rights.**
3. Buyer agrees the puppy purchased was purchased at pet/companion/service dog price and understands Buyer has no breeding rights to the puppy being purchased. Buyer agrees this puppy is not to be bred at any time, under any circumstances, either accidentally or intentionally. Buyer understands and agrees that if written proof of spay/neuter is not received by seller/Breeder on or before the date the puppy turned 12 months of age, the buyer shall surrender said

Puppy to Breeder (at buyers expense) for material breach of contract and shall also pay Breeder the sum of \$5000 as liquidated damages. If the said puppy is bred, whether intentionally or accidentally, the buyer agrees buyer shall surrender said Puppy back to the seller (at Byers soul expense) for material breach of contract and shall also pay Seller the sum of \$7,000 as liquidated damages, which is sellers best estimate as of the date of this concept of the difference between the pet/companion price and the breed price.
